

## Native Cotswold Wildflower Seed Mix Planting Instructions

- Sow April to November (later sowings will grow the following Spring)
- The seed can be sown onto bare ground, grass with the turf removed or well scarified grass. Removing turf or a layer of top soil will help reduce fertility and help the wildflowers establish
- The area should be in full sun and well drained but can be flat or sloping
- The seed in this packet should be enough to cover a couple of square metres
- Wildflowers prefer low fertility soil so don't use compost or fertilisers
- Tread in well
- If you have sown onto scarified grass, keep existing grass short until seedlings begin to show
- Once established, cut once a year in late summer and (optionally) once in early spring. It is important to remove any cuttings to reduce fertility
