

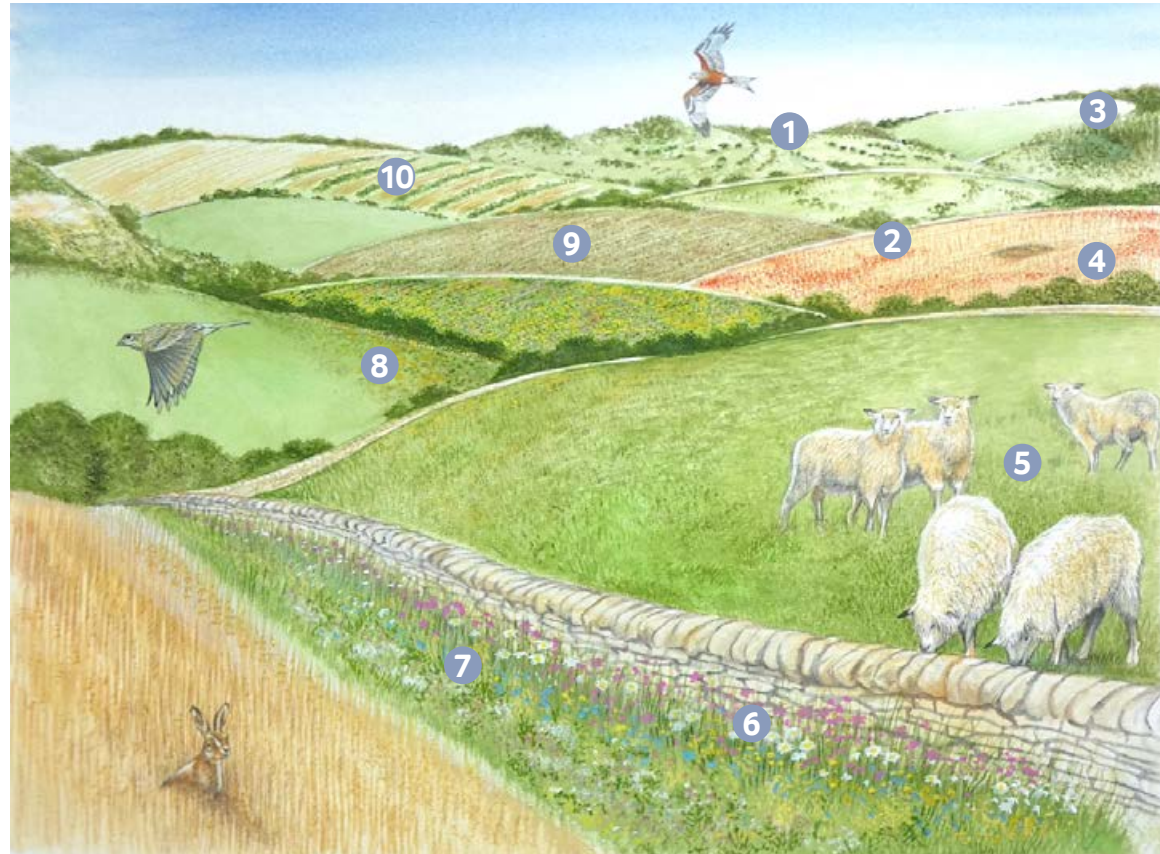
Cotswolds Nature Recovery Plan – A vision for nature’s recovery

Some of the features shown

- 1 Creation of a large area of extensively grazed mosaic habitat.
- 2 Measures in arable fields for arable flowers such as poppies
- 3 Woodland extent increased through natural regeneration extending an existing wood to link with another.
- 4 Measures in arable fields for farmland birds such as skylark plots.
- 5 Local breed – the Cotswold sheep or ‘lion’.
- 6 Restoration of dry stone walls.
- 7 Managed wildflower grassland margins around arable fields.
- 8 Hedgerows growing taller and thicker
- 9 Overwinter stubble and cover crops providing year round cover and conserving soils.
- 10 Agro-forestry.
