**Planning Application 18/0043/STMAJW:** Resubmission of withdrawn application 17/0082/CWMAJW for the change of use of an agricultural building to Use Class B2 and installation of proposed incinerator for the disposal of equine carcasses.

**Location:** Fourways Farm, Waterlane to Oakridge Crossroads, Waterlane, Oakridge, Gloucestershire GL6 7PH.

Thank you for consulting the Cotswolds Conservation Board ('the Board') on the above planning application.

Based on the plans submitted, the Board considers that the proposed development is not likely to have significant adverse impacts on the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). Therefore, the Board raises **no objection** to the proposed development.

As indicated in the Board's response to the previous application (17/0082/CWMAJW), should Gloucestershire County Council be minded to approve the application, consideration should be given to the following:

- The proposed flue should be painted a dark colour in order to minimise the impact on the surrounding landscape and reduce glint which could result from a galvanised flue.
