DESCRIPTION: Development of up to 500 dwellings (C3 Use Class) including means of access (two vehicular access points from the B4080 and a pedestrian/cycle access from Derwent Drive) and associated infrastructure and landscaping including provision of formal and informal open space and drainage attenuation basins

LOCATION: Land East of Bredon Road, Off Tewkesbury Road, Bredons Hardwick

Thank you for consulting the Cotswolds Conservation Board ('the Board') on this proposed development, which would be located in the setting of the Cotswolds National Landscape.¹

In reaching its planning decision, the local planning authority (LPA) has a statutory duty to have regard to the purpose of conserving and enhancing the natural beauty of the National Landscape.² The Board recommends that, in fulfilling this 'duty of regard', the LPA should: (i) ensure that planning decisions are consistent with relevant national and local planning policy and guidance; and (ii) take into account the following Board publications:

- Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) Management Plan 2018-2023 (link);
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Character Assessment (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Landscape Character Type (LCT) 19 (Unwooded Vale) and 1 (Escarpment Outliers) which the development could potentially be seen from;
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Strategy and Guidelines (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to LCT 19 (<u>link</u>), including Section 19.8, and LCT 1 (<u>link</u>), including Section 1.8;
- Cotswolds AONB Local Distinctiveness and Landscape Change (link);
- Cotswolds Conservation Board Position Statements (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Development in the Setting of the AONB Position Statement (<u>link</u>) and Tranquillity Position Statement (<u>link</u>) in particular section 4.5.

The Board's previous response, dated 13th July 2018, objected to this application due to the potential increase in traffic through the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty ('AONB') resulting from the proposed development and its potential significant adverse impact on the tranquillity of the AONB which is one of the AONB's 'special qualities'. The Board requested that the applicant undertook further assessments of the potential vehicle trips into/out of the AONB resulting from the proposed development, particularly in relation to the AONB villages around Bredon Hill.
