Policy PSP 24 Hydrocarbon Extraction (inc.Fracking) see attached response

Policy PSP 27 Rural Economy: Whilst **supportive** of this policy, the Board would wish the following issues to be included with respect to equestrian related development:

- A pasture and waste management plan is approved by the Council in order to ensure that the pasture remains in good condition and opportunities are taken to conserve and enhance biodiversity; and
- Permitted development rights for the erection of shelters, fences, jumps etc on the land are restricted to avoid visual clutter in the countryside.

Policy PSP 32 Telecommunications Infrastructure is **supported** by the Board as drafted.

Policy PSP 36 - Residential development in the countryside: The Board would wish to see the phrase "In all other circumstances, dwellings will only be allowed where special circumstances can be demonstrated." deleted from the Policy. What does constitute 'special circumstances' should be defined in the policy, not left to interpretation and possible abuse.

With respect to Part 2 of the Plan, the Board supports the aspirations of the following Parish Councils within the Cotswolds AONB to secure affordable housing at the level set out in the Plan. The Board supports no particular option for the location of such provision, but would expect the Council to undertake a landscape appraisal of each site which is located within the Cotswolds AONB as part of the assessment process:
