Background

- 1. The First Draft for Consultation was circulated to Natural England, Environment Agency, Forestry Commission, Historic England and the 15 local authorities within the AONB.
- Comments were received, however due to Officer sickness the incorporation of comments was delayed. This meant the Second Draft, due to be presented at the 9th November 2017 Executive to gain sign off for wider public consultation, was not considered or agreed. Consequently, at the Board meeting on 7th December 2017 a revised timeline was agreed.
- Comments have been now incorporated into a draft Second Draft for consultation, attached at Appendix A. Further comments from the Living and Working Sub-Committee are now invited prior to the Executive Committee on 25th January 2018. These will be reported verbally to the Executive.
- 4. Subject to detailed discussion at the 25th January 2018 Executive Committee and the review of the Second Draft alongside the Government's 25 year Environment Plan, consultation on the Second Draft will take place within the mid / late February mid March window.
- 5. It should be noted that this draft Second Draft remains in a text only version. Design and presentation will be addressed once the text has been agreed.
- 6. The aim would be for the Board to adopt the final Plan at its 28th June 2018 meeting.
