Background

Progress to date

- Work on the next business plan has already started. In early August Officers considered a draft detailed work programme and they also came together for a workshop on the 24th August. At this workshop they considered what they felt the Board should be doing to deliver the outcomes in the new management plan. This thinking informed the production of a revised detailed work programme which the attached summary work programme is based on.
- 2. In order to elicit responses the focus of the workshop was on suggesting what the Board should do and not who should do it. Consequently this early draft of the work programme has some tentative elements. The management team will be working on refining it for the first full draft of the business plan.
- 3. The business plan covers a three year period and a note is included where actions are not scheduled to be delivered within the first year.
- 4. The work programme is organised under the draft management plan's outcomes it is intended to help bring about. The draft management plan's ambitions and policies have been referred to in developing the work programme. It is proposed to undertake a detailed analysis of the alignment between the management plan's policies and the actions in the detailed work programme.
- 5. The Executive Committee is now being asked to comment on the draft business plan before the deadline of 5th October 2018.
