## Notes

- 1) Closing balance to cover 30 years of Management payments to landowners (based on 30.3ha Year 1 and 50ha Year 2). Management fees (site visits) plus contingency moved to A417 Biodiversity Fund and remaining surplus to be transferred to the Development Fund.
- 2) As agreed, future surpluses of GCG (which includes BNG) will be moved into the Development Fund. Remaining in the restricted GCG reserve will be a sum to cover six months of employee costs (£39k), equipment contingency (£30k) and the residual Esmee Fairbairn funding (£7k), totalling c. £76k for 2023/24. Surplus to be moved to Development Fund.
